STEP 1

- · CHECK **PARTS LIST**
 - Tools required 1 x Philips head screwdriver



1 x Front piece (Doors & Frame)



Rear Wall x 1 (install this way up) & face detail towards inside of cabinet



Side pieces x 2



(Shelves have folded edge)



2 x Floor piece / top pieces (no folded edge)



10 x Screws






STEP 2

· FITTING FRONT PIECE TO SIDE PIECES




Front piece slots into side when bottom corner lines up (enlargement).



Please note slot. This slot must be located front. bottom.



Push against back of front piece to secure.



Repeat other side.

STEP 3

· FITTING **REAR WALL** TO SIDES. AND SECURING



Rear wall goes inside (fig. A) and is then pulled forward (fig. B) and should fit snugly together.






Figure C is a view from above of how they fit.




Repeat this on the other side (if necessary open doors and push rear walls into alignment).



Once rear walls is in place secure it with screws at points 1,2,3,4,5 and 6.

STEP 4

· FITTING AND SECURING TOP PIECE



Push top piece into opening as shown. Ensuring the flaps are facing the front and screw holes are facing the back.




Secure top piece with screws at 1,2 and 3. Making sure that top piece is flush with the top of cabinet.




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
To finish securing top, the two small flaps at the front of the cabinet (fig. D) must be bent in as shown in Fig. E.



STEP 5

· FITTING FLOOR PIECE






The floor piece should sit neatly in the bottom of the cabinet.

PLEASE NOTE: Make sure you are using a floor piece not a shelf part. Also check folding flaps are located towards front of cabinet.

STEP 6


• SECURING THE UNDERSIDE



To secure the cabinet it needs to be placed on its side in order to allow access to its underneath.



First fold in the three flaps (1, 2 and 3) in as shown here in fig. B and in fig. C.



Then secure the base and rear wall with screw as shown (point 4).

STEP 7

· FITTING THE SHELVES















To fit a shelf, four hooks need to be placed at equal heights around the inside of the cabinet (fig. A, B). The hooks fit in as shown in fig. C, D and E.

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Place shelves on pre-positioned hooks.



Finished size: 1850mm high x 900mm wide x 450mm deep.
